

# PROJECT MLFE: MAKING LEARNING FUN AND ECOLOGICAL

## Get to know MLFE

The project **Making Learning Fun and Ecological** managed by the collaborative partnership of Eco - Logic, SYNTHESIS and Energap, and is an Erasmus+ project that **aims to develop learning and teaching materials on the topic of social entrepreneurship, linking it to environmental and climate matters.**

The project will make **materials that use gamification practices, available online (in a printable format), including a board game!** Gamification has shown itself to be highly important for **environmental goals** and **Eco - Logic**, the lead partner of this project, that has developed ample experience with this. The organization has already created one educational board game made for youngsters, on energy efficiency & climate change and sustainable urban transport and is working on more as well.

## Project partners

The project brings together partners from North Macedonia (**Eco-Logic**), Slovenia (**Energap**) and Cyprus (**Synthesis**). Each partner is an important piece in the overall project puzzle. **Eco-Logic**, a non-governmental, non-profit organization, is dedicated to the protection and conservation of the environment by encouraging and supporting the distribution of environmental knowledge and the upgrade of ecological education:

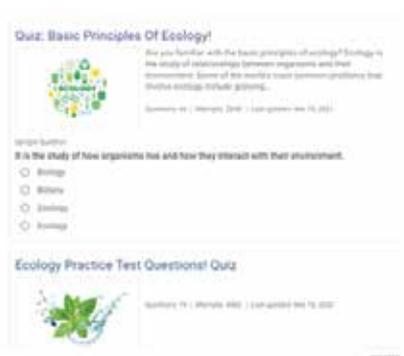


## What we do now – in progress

The team is currently working to create interesting interactive activities on the topic of eco-social entrepreneurship. Within the project, we have started with the setup of an **educational web page** that will contain didactic materials on the topic. The idea is to stimulate young people on detecting and discussing community issues related to environmental topics, and to propose various solutions that have an economic potential, thus directly targeting social entrepreneurship, and youth unemployment.

We have already conducted a survey in order to evaluate the ways of thinking of the youth and educators that will contribute to the web page itself, in terms of content, visual aspect, as well as functionality.

The online platform will be an innovative place, targeted at young people, teachers, non-formal educators and other professionals working with young people, wherein everyone with internet access will be able to freely access engaging educational materials that promote young people to become more engaged and empowered towards eco-social entrepreneurship, awareness of environmental and climate matters, and learning valuable skills.

Our first brochure is already out for anyone who wants to get basic information about the project objectives, the planned activities and the target groups of the project.
